

## Senior Year Considerations

### December:

- ✓ SAT subject tests, if needed and not taken by now, must be taken this month. Only very few selective schools will use SAT or ACT exams taken after the start of the new year.
- ✓ Federal Financial aid forms (FAFSA) should be available by mid-December. You can always create an account at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov), and submit when completed on January 1<sup>st</sup>.
- ✓ Turn in forms for mid-year grades and/or transcripts if they are a part of the admissions application process.
- ✓ Critical month for highly selective school deadlines.
- ✓ Other points to keep in mind and scheduled on your calendar, if you have not already done so:

#### **Federal Deadline for Aid**

Online applications must be submitted by midnight Central Time, June 30, 2014.  
Any corrections or updates must be submitted by midnight Central Time, September 20, 2014.

#### **State Deadline for Aid**

Oregon - OSAC Private Scholarships - March 1, 2014 by midnight, Central Time.  
Oregon Opportunity Grant - February 1, 2014 by midnight, Central Time.

#### **College Deadline**

Check with the college(s) you are interested in attending. You may also want to ask your college about its definition of an application deadline - whether it is the date the college receives your FAFSA, or the date your FAFSA is processed.
